



Installation Instructions: MJ1 JEEP GLADIATOR 5'3" BED LENGTH (2020-CURRENT)

TOOLS REOUIRED

- adjustable wrench (that opens to about 1") 7/16" deep socket
- 1/2" open end wrench
- #2 Phillip screwdriver
- short 7/32" hex wrench
- 3/8" socket

- electric drill
- 9/64" drill bit
- drill stop
- Torx 45 driver
- 10" socket extension

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

▼ HEY! TORQUE BOY: READ <u>BEFORE</u> YOU INSTALL DECKED ▼

- 1. **DON'T** be "that guy", please read the instructions.
- 2. Use fingers to start all bolts to avoid crossthreading.
- 3. **DON'T** over tighten bolts, get em' hand-tight.
- 4. **DON'T** use power tools.


- 5. If you don't follow directions and *do* use power tools:
 1). Set clutch at a very low setting.
 2). If you blow it, see NOTE.*
- 6. **DON'T** over tighten J-hooks during installation. Make 'em good and snug enough to keep the system from moving in the bed.
- 7. Nice job if you're still reading .
- **NOTE*** Two extra threaded inserts are included in **BAG PREP-EXTRA**. That's all you get. The inserts will replace any stripped inserts in the tailgate ammo cans, but NOT THE CENTER VERT, so hand tighten until snug only! You can also screw the inserts back in if dislocated. There is a straight screwdriver slot on the underside of the insert.



PREPARE BED: INSTALL BED TAPE

To protect your paint: INSTALL THIS TAPE BEFORE YOU INSTALL YOUR DECKED SYSTEM

- \cdot You will not need this tape if you have a spray-in bed liner, Bedrug or mat.
- There is a strip of protective tape provided: BAG BED TAPE MJ1.
- Clean the surfaces where the protective tape will be located isopropal alcohol is recommended.
- Cut the tape strip into 7" lengths. Apply to locations in **DETAIL A** and repeat for the right side.






PREPARE BED: INSTALL SHIMS


• There are 12 SHIMS provided: BAG SHIM-JEEP GLADIATOR.

- Using the information in the respective circular detail views:
- Clean the surfaces where the shims will be located (isopropyl alcohol is recommended).
- Remove the layer of tape on the bottom of the shim to expose the adhesive surface.
- Place the shim and apply with pressure.




PREPARE BED: MARK CENTER OF BED

- Using a tape measure, locate centerline of bed floor (blue), which may be raised or depressed.
- \cdot Use a marking pen or wax pencil to mark the centerline on shim.
- Mark centerline on cabside panel.




PREP BED: CABSIDE TIE DOWNS (LET'S DO THIS!)

- Using a Torx T45 bit, remove screw from cabside tie down ring and remove ring.
- \cdot Set aside screw and ring; they will not be reused.
- Repeat process for opposite side cargo ring.



PREP BED: CABSIDE TIE DOWNS (NOW YOU'RE ACTUALLY GETTING SOMEWHERE!)


- Install u-nuts onto cabside mounting brackets in the direction shown; BAG PREP MJ1.
- Install bedside mounting bracket with 1" Torx 45 screw, using T45 Torx bit; **BAG PREP MJ1**. Verify bracket orientation is as shown.
- Tighten securely.
- Repeat this sequence for the passenger side cabside mounting bracket.



ASSEMBLY: CENTER VERT + CABSIDE VERT


NOTE: Perform the next few steps on a flat surface.

• Attach center vert to cabside vert with four bolts. Alternate to tighten; BAG S1.



ASSEMBLY: LOOSELY ATTACH STUDS


• LOOSELY attach studs to cabside vert with six bolts; BAG S1.



ASSEMBLY: ALIGN & TIGHTEN STUDS

NOTE: This step ensures the studs are properly located before tightening bolts. It's important.

- Place ammo cans to support tailgate end of deck panels.
- · Lift deck panels on center vert + stud + cabside vert assembly.
- Slide studs around L-R until deck panels are seated.
- DETAIL A: Loosely secure four bolts to hold decks onto studs; BAG S1.
- · Now you can securely tighten the bolts that hold the studs to the cabside vert.
- Unbolt deck from studs, remove deck panels, save bolts, remove ammo cans and set aside for later assembly.




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ASSEMBLY: STUD BRACKETS


- Per **DETAIL A**, attach stud bracket to left stud using (2) 3.5" bolts and (2) nuts, **BAG PREP MJ1**, making note of the proper hole locations.
- Verify orientation as shown. Repeat on right side.
- Tighten nuts securely.

RECOMMENDED TORQUE: Bolts in labeled bag PREP MJ1 - 27 in-lb.







ASSEMBLY: MOUNT ASSEMBLY


- Install cabside vert/stud assembly in pickup bed and position against cabside panel of bed.
- Align molded-in centerline markings on cabside vert with the centerline marks on the pickup bed.
- The stud bracket must be located on the tailgate side of the cabside bracket.





www.mopar.com **ASSEMBLY:** MOUNT ASSEMBLY


- Referencing DETAIL A, using a 10" socket extension, loosely assembly .905" bolt through top slot in stud bracket into U-nut in cabside bracket; BAG S1. Tighten bolt securely.
- Repeat on right side.



www.mopar.com **INSTALL:** C CHANNELS

IMPORTANT: There is a left and right ammo can. The inside of each ammo can is marked L or R.


- Loosely place left side ammo can at tailgate corner of bed. The axle will be closest to you.
- Place C-channel on ledge of stud and ammo can with end plate on the stud (cabside).
- DETAIL A: Place nylon washer on eight .905" bolts. Insert two bolts through C-channel into ammo can and loosely fasten with flanged nuts. Make sure the bolt head is on the C-channel side, not inside the ammo can; BAG S1, BAG MS WASHER, BAG N1. KEEP LOOSE.
- DETAIL B: Attach C-channel to stud with same bolts; BAG S1.
- Repeat right side.



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INSTALL: DECK HALVES

- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Loosely place deck panel on side stud, center vert and ammo can.
- Shift ammo can forward, rearward, L-R, as necessary to align with fully seated deck panel.
- Loosely assemble:
 - Five bolts through deck panel into center vert; BAG S1.
 - Four bolts with nylon and rubber washers installed as shown through deck panel into stud; **BAG S1, BAG MS WASHERS.**
 - Eight bolts with nylon and rubber washers installed as shown through deck panel into ammo can;
 BAG S1, BAG MS WASHERS. Use the four nylon washers from BAG S1 and remaining 20 nylon washers from BAG MS WASHERS to complete this step for both sides.
 - Tighten all **S1** bolts.
 - \cdot Securely tighten C-Channel/ammo can nuts and bolts.
- Repeat other side (making sure you don't forget to securely tighten C-channel/ammo can nuts and bolts).





INSTALL: J-HOOKS

- **Loosely** assemble J-hook assembly in order shown through the **TAILGATE** side hole in ammo can; **BAG J7C**.
- Repeat other side.










HELPFUL TIP: make sure the hooks open toward cabside.

DRAWERS: BRACKETS + WHEELS (SO EASY A CHIMPANZEE CAN DO IT)


- Each drawer has a left and a right bracket. Bolt the brackets into place via bottom two holes in bracket with 3/4" length bolts. Use the 2" length bolt for the upper cabside wall hole in bracket; **BAG DRAWER 1**.
- Install a tube brace in each drawer with two 3/4" length bolts; BAG DRAWER 1, BAG DRAWER 2.
- Attach wheels onto the drawer brackets with a 7/32" hex wrench; BAG WHEELS.




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DRAWERS: AXLE WHEELS + WEATHERSTRIPS

- Slide narrow drawer into the left side drawer cavity. **NOTE:** It is easier to fully install narrow drawer first.
- **DETAIL A:** Install two tailgate wheels onto narrow drawer axles with a 7/32" Allen key; **BAG WHEELS.**
- Repeat with wide drawer.
- DETAIL B: Install weatherstrips on top of drawer edges *WITH WIPER BLADE POINTING TOWARD DRIVER.* IMPORTANT: Incorrect installation of the weatherstrip will funnel water into the drawer!






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FINAL STEPS: TORSION BRACE + BOTTLE OPENER

• Slide torsion brace under center support and tailgate ammo cans.

NOTE: Ensure the J-hooks are not tight.

- Loosely install:
 - Two .905" bolts with nylon washers through the end holes in torsion brace into ammo cans; BAG PREP MJ1.
 - Two .905" bolts with nylon washers through the bottom bottle opener holes and torsion brace into center vert; **BAG PREP MJ1.**
 - \cdot Two 1/2" length bolts through upper holes in bottle opener into center vert; BAG FINAL MID.
- Align bottle opener to edges of center vert and tighten four bottle opener bolts.
- Tighten end bolts into tailgate ammo cans.
- Finally, tighten the J-hooks! DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN. Make sure the gap between the sidewall of the bed and the deck is equal on both sides.




FINAL STEPS: THE RULER

• Center ruler in embossed area and screw three 1/2" length Phillips screws through the tailgate side holes directly into deck panels; **BAG FINAL MID.**

NOTE: These are small gauge screws. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.

- For the three cabside ruler mounting holes, drill each with a 9/64" drill bit and a drill stop set to 1/2". There is a lateral steel tube that runs on the underside of the deck at this location. (SEE UNDERSIDE VIEW OF DECK).
 IMPORTANT: Only drill through <u>TOP</u> of steel tube; do not drill through bottom of tube, otherwise you will funnel water into your drawers.
- Screw three 3/4" length Phillips screws into the cabside ruler holes you just drilled; BAG FINAL MID.



UNDERSIDE VIEW OF DECK



DO: Drill through the top of steel tube ONLY.


DO NOT: Drill through both sides of steel tube.



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FINAL STEPS: AMMO CAN LIDS

- DETAIL A: Ammo can lids are left (marked L) and right (marked R) side specific.
- **DETAIL B:** Holding lid in orientation shown, insert tab on tailgate end of ammo can lid and push the cabside end of lid down to secure. Don't be afraid to push down hard.
- Insert lock hole plugs, unless you ordered drawer locks. Install drawer locks now (instructions with locks); BAG FINAL MID.
