2011 & 2012 Ford Super Duty 20" E-Series/SR Series Installation Instructions

Wiring Instructions For Factory Upfitter Switches:



Always disconnect battery before servicing any fuses or electrical system

The following instructions are for installation & wiring for 2011 Ford Super Duty equipped with OEM Upfitter switches.

*If your vehicle was not equipped from the factory with the Upfitter switches, they can be purchased through your local Ford dealer along with the associated wiring harness.

**A universal wiring harness is included that can be modified for trucks without Upfitter switches.

Step 1

Identify Upfitter wiring harness, located near driver's side kick panel, above emergency brake pedal. This is where you will obtain power for the 20" E-Series lightbar



Switch 1 – Yellow (20A fused) – Recommended location for 20" E Series Rigid Lightbar Switch 2 – Green with Brown Stripe (20A fused) Switch 3 – Violet with Green Stripe (10A fused) Switch 4 – Brown (15A fused)

<u>Step 2</u> Suggested grounding location is shown highlighted in the photo below



Step 3

Locate a suitable location in the body to pass wiring harness for E Series Lightbar through vehicle cab. Ensure wiring is routed to prevent chafing.

Step 4 Mounting of Light Bracket

The bracket supplied with this kit has been designed to use pre-existing holes already located in the bumper from the factory, so **no drilling is required**. When installing the bracket, it is critical to leave all bolts slightly loose until the final step. This will greatly aid in proper positioning of the light & bracket.

Note, on vehicles equipped with the factory engine block heater

The wiring harness for the engine block heater will need to be relocated slightly in order to utilize the factory hole for the E Series Lightbar bracket. Relocate block heater harness to suitable location.



Install supplied clip onto this location after harness is removed & relocated.

Also install supplied clip into corresponding location on driver's side

These will be the locations where the bracket will bolt to in the rear

Step 5

Install supplied fastener clips (2ea) into top section of bumper opening as indicated in photo below



This will be where the bracket bolts to in the front

Step 6

Install bracket using supplied hardware making sure all bolts are slightly loose until final assembly

Step 7

Remove nuts from side of lightbar & place light into position on bracket (Do not reinstall nuts at this time)

Step 8

Remove 8mm bolts from bottom of bumper opening & install bracket side supports as shown below. Reinstall nut onto light bar & check alignment.



Step 9

Once satisfied with alignment & position of bracket, tighten all bolts & nuts.

Step 10

Connect lightbar pigtail to wiring harness previously installed.

Congratulations! Your new lightbar is now ready for duty.



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
