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PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Remove the valance guard by removing screws from the front underside of the vehicle. See Figure 1.
- 3. Remove the license plate and remove the license plate holder by removing the two screws. See Figure 2.





4. Under the hood of the vehicle remove screws and plastic push-pins to remove the grille. Once removed carefully pull off the grille guard. See Figures 3 and 4.





5. Remove plastic cover on both sides by removing the plastic push-pins. See Figure 5.





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- 6. It may be necessary to bend the aluminum A/C line by hand so that it does not interfere with the upper bracket. See **Figures** 6 and **Figure 7**.
- 7. Locate (1) frame reinforced mount bracket and loosely secure onto frame channel using (4) M10 hex head cap screws, (4) M10 split lock washers, (4) small M10 flat washers, (4) large M10 flat washers and (4) M10 hex nuts. NOTE: Use the large M10 flat washers on the frame side. NOTE: The radiator may have to be loosened to allow proper clearance to install the bracket, once in place the radiator may be re-tightened. Repeat step for other side. See Figures 8 and 9.



- 8. Remove the front plastic bumper insert. **Refer to Figure 5.** Locate the provided trim templates and align along the inside of the front plastic bumper insert. Follow instructions on the trim template and trim area as necessary. Reinstall front bumper. **See Figure 10.**
- 9. Insert (1) upper support strap through the recently trimmed slots on the bumper. Loosely attach the upper support straps onto the previously installed frame reinforced mount bracket using (1) medium M12 hex head cap screw, (2) small M12 flat washers, (1) M12 split lock washer and (1) M12 hex nut. Repeat for other side. See Figures 11 and 12.
- 10. Tighten M12 hardware of upper support strap to 50-55 ft-lbs.
- 11. Locate factory bolt on the frame and remove. Repeat for both sides. See Figure 13.





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- 12. Locate (1) lower mount bracket and loosely install onto frame location where factory bolt was removed using (1) short M12 hex head cap screw, (1) M12 split lock washer and (1) small M12 flat washer. Loosely secure top mounting hole using (1) long M12 hex head cap screw, (1) small M12 flat washer, (1) large M12 flat washer, (1) M12 split lock washer and (1) M12 hex nut. NOTE: Large M12 flat washer is used on the frame side. NOTE: Remove bracket if present on mounting location. See Figure 14.
- 13. Reinstall the plastic covers and grille in the reverse order that they were taken off.
- 14. Loosely install the winch tray onto the previously installed lower mount brackets using (6) M12 hex socket button head screws, (12) M12 flat washers, (6) M12 split lock washers and (6) M12 hex nuts. See Figure 15.
- 15. With assistance, loosely install the grille guard assembly onto the winch tray and the lower mount brackets using the provided M10 hardware (Item 25 27). See Figure 16.
- 16. Align and adjust the Winch Tray and Grille Guard Assembly as necessary. Tighten all remaining hardware: M10 to 30-35 ft-lbs and M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.
