




APPLICATION: 2001-08 FORD RANGER/RANGER "EDGE" (EXCL. STX) 2001-12 MAZDA B-SERIES



- Remove the contents from box and check for damage. Verify all parts are present. Read instructions STEP 1. completely before beginning.






FIGURE 1 INSTALLATION VIEW OF DRIVER SIDE SHOWN

- Attach brackets to outside face of frame members with 1/2" fasteners and backing plate as shown. Leave STEP 2. loose. SEE FIGURES 1 AND 2.
- STEP 4. Attach support brace using holes in bottom face of vehicle frame. SEE FIGURE 1. NOTE: If vehicle has a plastic shroud mounted to bottom of frame, remove bolts with 10mm socket and remove "push type" fasteners from shroud. Place support brace against bottom of frame, reinstall plastic shroud with factory bolts and replace "push type" fasteners with 5/16" self tapping screw. Leave loose.
- STEP 5. Attach support bracket to mount bracket using 3/8" fasteners. SEE FIGURE 1.
- Attach safari bar using 1/2" fasteners. SEE FIGURE 1-3. STEP 6.
- Level and adjust Safari Bar as desired and tighten all fasteners. Recommended torque values are 64 Ft. STEP 7. Lbs. for 1/2" fasteners, 26 Ft. Lbs. for 3/8" fasteners, 10 Ft. Lbs. for 6mm fasteners, and 15 Ft. Lbs. for 5/16"

FINISH PROTECTION

Westin products have a high quality finish that must be cared for like any other exposed finish on the vehicle. Protect the finish with a non-abrasive automotive wax, (e.g. Pure Carnauba) on a regular basis. The use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental, as the compounds scratch the finish and open it to corrosion.
