




PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting on the driver side, remove the rubber plugs located on the rocker panel at each mounting location. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. **For models with threaded holes:** At each bracket mounting location on the rocker panel there should be a welded factory nut.





- 4. Locate (1) Mounting Bracket (Items 3) and loosely secure it to the rocker panel using the provided hardware: (2) M8 hex head bolt, (2) M8 flat washer, and (2) M8 lock washer. See **Figure 2.**
- 5. Repeat Step 4 for all remaining bracket mounting locations.



- 6. For step bar installation, use the supplied M10 Hardware to loosely secure the step bar to the preinstalled brackets. See **Figures 3 & 4**. *Note: All brackets install similarly to step bar*.
- 7. Align and adjust the step bars and brackets as needed, then fully tighten all hardware: M8 to 18 ft-lbs, M10 to 38 ft-lbs.
